The workshop will feature early 17th-century madrigals by Johann Steffens; *La Bomba*, an extensive musical potpourri, or *ensalada* (salad), by the Renaissance Spanish composer Mateo Flecha, and selections by Edvard Grieg, including a canon, a setting for recorders of the song *Våren* (*Spring*) and movements from *Peer Gynt*.

Thomas Axworthy has served as director of the Los Angeles Recorder Orchestra and the Southern California Early Music Consort. He is co-founder of the early music ensemble, Canto Antigo, and co-director of the Canto Antigo Workshop in Early Music and Dance. He has taught at Rio Hondo College and directed the Collegium for the Claremont Graduate School. He has appeared with the Los Angeles Philharmonic and can be heard on numerous movie and television soundtracks. He has recorded for the Musical Heritage Society, Nonesuch, Dargason, Titanic and Word Records.

Directions:

From 101: Take the Willow Road exit west to Menlo Park. Turn right onto Middlefield Road. Take a left at the second signal (Ravenswood Ave.). The church is on the corner of Ravenswood and Laurel Street. The entrance to the parking lot is off Ravenswood just after Pine Street before you get to the signal at Laurel.

From 280: Take the Sand Hill Road exit toward the Bay. Turn left on El Camino Real and proceed to Menlo Park. Turn right at Ravenswood Avenue and proceed to Laurel Street. The church is on the left at the corner of Laurel and Ravenswood. The entrance to the parking lot is off Ravenswood after the signal at Laurel past the church building to the left.

Parking is limited in the church lot. Do not park in spaces reserved for tenants. Please see the MPRO website for overflow parking instructions in the SRI lot across Ravenswood from the church or on adjacent streets.

Please note that the Menlo Park CalTrain station is just a couple blocks from the church if you'd like to try public transportation.
